A DREAM taking shape—Don Bosco Sadan (Rehabilitation Centre for Boys)

Don Bosco Sadan, a Rehabilitation Centre for Boys at Monvila, Thiruvananthapuram was officially inaugurated by Shri. Antony Raju (Hon. Minister for Road Transport, Govt of Kerala) on 26 November 2022.

The centre, envisioned by BREADS, is part of its Drug Rehabilitation Education and Mentoring (DREAM) initiative across 10 districts of Kerala. In 2021-22, DREAM empowered more than 400,000 children and youth to dream beyond drugs in the identified areas of need, providing counselling, as well as training for parents and teachers.





In an effort to plug a stark gap in available services, Don Bosco Sadan will provide children and youth in Kerala, a *Way to Sobriety and Health* through residential rehabilitation and deaddiction services for children below 18 years.

Its offered services include inpatient and outpatient treatment adapted to individual needs, free food and accommodation, various formats of counselling – individual, group & family, life skills training, and recreational activities.

The activities of Don Bosco Sadan are designed to treat more than just addiction. They will also address the root causes of the behavioural and emotional issues of the children and their related needs. At a given time, the centre can accommodate 15 children, whose assessment and treatment will be determined by a qualified team comprising a doctor/psychiatrist, nurse and counsellor. A professional medical and psychiatric social worker will support families, and other outreach activities of the centre. After the residential treatment, ongoing progress of the children will be monitored through aftercare services offered by local DREAM teams in the various districts.

Don Bosco Sadan will also promote awareness about the adverse impact of addictions, and the benefits of counselling and rehabilitation services through its outreach programmes. As a much-needed service for children in need of rehabilitation, many local NGOs and government officials have welcomed the inauguration of the centre, and together look forward to the successful functioning of Don Bosco Sadan.
