I have rights, You have rights, We all have rights



As a refresher, here are the rights of a child as enshrined in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC), which came into effect on 20 November 1989.

India is one of the 196 countries across the world, who are signatories to this treaty. In India, besides World Child Rights Day, we additionally celebrate 14 November as Children's Day in honour of Jawaharlal Nehru, our first Prime Minister, who was known as a friend to children.



BREADS' partners across Karnataka and Kerala celebrated children's rights all through the month through events, meetings, child rights awareness programmes, and especially through their work on the ground.

I have the Right to Life

In a rescue mission on 25 November 2023, the Child Safety Net (CSN) team of BOSCO Bangalore (BREADS' partner) rescued a 20 day-old boy from being trafficked by his parents in Bangalore. Upon receiving information that a couple from Tamil Nadu, were attempting to sell their child, the CSN team in collaboration with the local as well as Central Crime Branch police, caught the baby's mother and three other associates involved in the crime.



The illicit operation headed by a woman, targeted childless families, promising them a child for amounts

ranging from 300,000 to 500,000 rupees. They would then identify financially vulnerable families with infants aged 2-3 months and offer them money in exchange for the child.

Following the intervention, the newborn was taken to the Government Vanivilas Hospital for immediate medical attention and care. CSN promptly informed the Chairman of the Child Welfare Committee. On 27 November, the baby was discharged from the hospital under the supervision of appropriate authorities and admitted to Amruth Shishu Nivas in Basawanakudi, Bangalore, following the CWC order.

The timely intervention and collaboration between the CSN team, law enforcement and healthcare professionals led to the rescue of the newborn and the apprehension of the traffickers. This case highlights the vulnerability of children of financially-distressed families and underscores the importance of prompt action and collaboration among various agencies to safeguard the fundamental rights of children.

I have the Right to Protection

Don Bosco CHITHRA (BREADS' partner) prevented an underage girl from being married off by her family in Karobaiyanahatti village, Chitradurga in Karnataka on November 9, 2023.

The social workers collaborated successfully with the Department of Women and Child Development, Headmaster of the Govt. High School, CHILDLINE, District Child Protection Unit, and the Police, to ensure the prevention of the marriage and that the child continues her education.



This rescue again brings into focus the need for a strong community watch and proactive child protection systems to ensure that all children, especially the vulnerable, are protected from violations of their rights—whether trafficking, child labour, child marriage or neglect. The CREAM initiative by BREADS was particularly responsible for creating thousands of informed children and adults, who are now champions of the rights of children.

I have the Right to Development

Besides the basic needs, children need opportunity—to develop into a full person, able to explore their potential. BREADS together with Social Service Guild, commemorated Children's Day on 12 November 2023 at Kristu Jyoti



College, Krishnarajapuram. The day was a joyous occasion for the 400 children who attend the ten evening supplementary education centres, across the East Bangalore region. Various competitions—group dance, music, mono-act, elocution, and literary events were organised, providing a platform for the children to showcase their talents and creativity. It was an opportunity for the children to interact with new people, and gain experience and exposure. Games, entertainment sessions, chance games etc. were organised by the volunteers of Kristu Jyothi College, Bangalore.

Fr. George PS, Executive Director—BREADS, addressed the children on the optimum and responsible use of child

rights for their own safety and protection, and that of their friends as well. He also distributed prizes to the winners of the competitions.

Similarly, with Don Bosco CHITHRA, a *Makkalotsava* (children's festival), was conducted on 19 November 2023, for 450 children of 15 evening tuition centres in Chitradurga. The children actively participated, played games, and received gifts, contributing to the joyous atmosphere of the event. The programme also featured group singing and dance competitions, allowing the children to showcase their talents and creativity.



Similar programmes were organised across all the partnering organisations of BREADS in both Karnataka and Kerala. These Children's Day celebrations resonated with the core mission of BREADS – to empower children through an educative presence by creating an environment that nurtures their holistic development.





I have the Right to Participate



dren from five villages in Ramasamundra Gram Panchayat, Yadagiri district, actively participated in the Makkala ers. Grama Sabha (MGS) (children's parliament) on 22 November 2023.

The MGS encouraged children's involvement in discussions related to village and school developments. During the MGS, children voiced their concerns and demands for improved school infrastructure, essential amenities like plates and glasses for the midday meal, water facilities, school compound walls, playgrounds, and the construction of an anganwadi building in Ashanal tanda. The

officials carefully listened to the children's demands, assuring them that the issues would be addressed in the coming two months.

Don Bosco Centre for Social Action in Yadagiri played an active role in the MGS by organising 40 children from its four activity centres in Ramasamundra and Bangarammanagudi villages.
