Bridging Education and Skill Divide

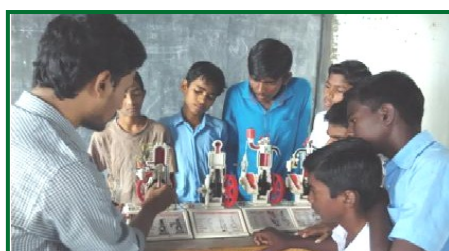

BREADS DB Tech has been at the forefront in mainstreaming youth, ensuring economic security and attaining sustainable development by enhancing the skills of the youth at risk of poverty, in Kerala and Karnataka. This attempt intensified with DB Tech shaping into a network of Don Bosco Technical Training Institutes in India. BREADS DB Tech has made its mark in Karnataka and Kerala in the year 2015 – 2016 by running 41 centres; with 4 of its centres being acknowledged as the best centres for their passion and commitment to help young people learn employable skills and start their career. As of now, we have an impressive number of 41 skill training centres; of which 22 are in Karnataka and 19 in Kerala. BREADS DB Tech provides training in the automobile sector in 57 government schools under the National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) programme by the Govt. of Karnataka. Among them, are 5 NCVT (National Council of Vocational Training) formal centres, 24 non-formal centres and 12 short-term Vocational/Skill training centres. DB Tech programs are rolled out not only in Don Bosco centres but also in collaboration with 57 government school and 10 other like-minded partners in Kerala and Karnataka. As of now, we have 20 projects supported by the governments of Kerala and Karnataka, corporations and companies.

Shivanand of Ameerabad Wadi, Bidar, is from a family where his father is the only breadwinner in the family. However, due to drought in his village for the past 8 months, his father could not work on the farm, thereby losing their only income. Though Shivanand is a certificate holder from ITI, he was not able to find a job to help his family; hence he was depressed and disappointed. He had done his share of job hunting but without success and this also frustrated him. His friend told him about the skill training and job placements provided by DB Tech, Bidar. The very next day he came to DB Tech Bidar to get admission into the retail skill training programme. That he travelled 35 to 40 kms daily to the institute to attend the training indicated his dedication. He was regular and learnt spoken English, retail customer interaction, work skills, life skills and computer skills. Now he is placed at the Shri Venkateshwara (Indian Oil) filling station, Bidar, as a manager. He gets a take-home salary of Rs. 6500 per month and is happy to help his family. The joy on his face was peerless when he got through the interview, and said that the DB Tech training has changed his fate- not only the education that matters but the moulding too which he got from the training center.
