Skilled to Succeed... Moving Beyond Skills



India is a fast growing economy in the world and this economy requires an educated and skilled working force to power its growth. Skills must be the driving force for innovation and growth. Vocational training must become an integral part of our formal education at schools that can spark students at an early stage to explore in skill development and training. Our education programmes must be in tune with global needs and changes; it should thus provide the foundation for skill development. Skilled workers can enhance efficiency at work; skills also enable flexibility and job mobility. Different data shows that efficient, skilled workers are less in the Indian job sectors. Therefore, there was a considerable effort from the Ministry of Labour and Employment to create various schemes, including setting up the National Skill Development Corporation, India in 2009 to train/skill 500 million people in India by 2020.

Fulfilling the Need of the Hour

Don Bosco Tech Society has more than 420 vocational training institutes across 29 states in India with the mission to skill youth in 66 domains. DB Tech has already trained 343979 students and 8662 trainees are in the classroom now. DB Tech BREADS has 44 centres; out of which, 22 centres are in Karnataka and 22 centres in Kerala. Training initiatives are undertaken at the rural and urban areas to fight against unemployment, to create knowledgeable and skilled employees, and to explore the enormous amount of job opportunities in the vocational training sector.

- ♦ The Government of India has launched initiatives to train over 40 crore people in different skills by 2022.
- ♦ Only 2.3% of the workforce in India has undergone formal skill training.
- ♦ India has the second largest workforce in the world after China's.
- ♦ Fresh employment opportunities are being created in the fields of engineering, retail, hospitality, ecommerce, media, tourism and banking but there is a shortfall of trained people.
- ♦ 387.34 million in India work in the unorganized sectors.
- ♦ India ranked 124 out of 136 countries for women's economic participation in 2013 by the World Economic Forum.
- ♦ India has less than 10,000 vocational training institutes to cater to the skill development of its population.
- ♦ The skill Loan Scheme has made available Rs. 5000 to 1.5 Lakh to the youth who wish to attend skill development programmes.
