While the global population is ageing rapidly, India, with one of the youngest populations in the world, is at a strategic advantage with respect to demographic dividend. However, almost three fourth of India's population is unskilled. There is a wide gap between the skills required in industry and those provided by the education system. Despite the efforts of the National Skills Development Mission the task of achieving the target - 500 million skilled manpower by 2022, seems daunting. Several path-breaking public-private partnerships like the National Skills Development Corporation (NSDC) are leading significant changes by increasing the supply of training providers.

BREADS in partnership with DB Tech, Central Ministry of Rural Development and Corporate Bodies has been engaged in the field of skill training from 2010. In the last four years thousands of young people were trained in various domains and given jobs. BOSCO Bangalore trains Police and Railway authorities on Child Rights



Skill Trainings - Bridging skills gaps



The need for bridging skills gap in Karnataka has received a fresh acknowledgement of late, with the Bangalore Chamber of Industry and Commerce observing the inadequate steps taken by State Government to address skill deficit. BCIC had also recommended the revamping of ITIs and other vocational education institutions. With the discourse on addressing skill deficit in Karnataka getting more concrete, BREADS continues to contribute in the best way it could.

With the discourse on addressing skill deficit in Karnataka getting more concrete, BREADS continues to contribute in the best way it could. Since 2010 BREADS has been making successful strides in skilling underprivileged children, in collaboration with multiple partners. Remarkably, the teams have been endeavouring to place the trained students in sustainable jobs, introducing them to the market. This placement advantage along with the teaching of Communicative English, Basic Computers and Life Skills as an additional package, have proven to be the key factors attracting stu-



dents from the unreached areas.

There are presently 16 skill training centres administered through the Don Bosco institutions in Kerala, and another 11 centres in Karnataka. Currently, the domains finding active takers are – Retail, Hospitality, Electrical, Business Process Outsourcing, Beautician, Industrial Sewing Machine Operator, Information Technology & Enabled Services, Tally and Office Administration.

Darshan from Kushalnagar, Kodagu district comes from a family of four members. His Father is a news paper hawker, Mother - a homemaker and younger brother in class 9. A shy and simple person with a minimum qualification of SSLC, but had no added technical skills. He says "I wanted to learn computers as it is the modern trend and pays high salary". But his family's income could not afford him the requisite education.

On learning about the Don Bosco skill training through auto announcements, he met the DB Tech trainers. He joined Don Bosco Makkalalaya, Mysore training center for Quest S2S Retail training. Since he was interested in computers, the online learning excited him. He says "The training was a wonderful experience for me. It was really motivating. The training has not only imparted knowledge and skills but has also given me a chance to groom myself, learn etiquettes to perform better in the outside world. This is the best that could ever happen to me. I heartily thank all my trainers for this for making me what I am".

Today, Darshan is working as a Customer Service Executive in Dominos Pizza, at Mall Of Mysore Branch. Salary of 7000/- rupees per month, along with incentives has not only made his family happy, but has encouraged Darshan to aim higher in life.
