National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF) - Skilling India & empowering youth



Government of Karnataka Selected BREADS- DB Tech to impart the NSQF scheme in 57 Schools of Karnataka state to conduct skill training in Automotive Sector. This is a Government of India sponsored scheme of Vocationalisation of Secondary Education by integrating employability education into School Education. Through this scheme BREADS- DB Tech will reach out 1425 schools students of Class IX across 28 districts of Karnataka state with Vocational Skill training, Life Skill training and Motivational Sessions.

The key elements and components of NSQF

In order to address the various issues related to Vocational Education and Training (VET), attention has been given by the Government to develop a Qualifications Framework to integrate the qualifications of technical, vocational and academic education. The key elements of this scheme are:

- National principles for providing Vocational Education (VE) leading to international equivalency.
- Multiple entry and exit between VE, general education and job markets,
- Progression within VE,
- Transfer between VE and general education, and
- Partnership with industry/employers

The following are the components integrated in NSQF

- Integrating Vocational Education with main stream General Education.
- National Occupation Standards (NOS): The NOS for each job role within the identified skill sectors will be laid down by the Sector Skill Councils (SSCs).
- Industry Engagement: Participation of the industry and employers will be a critical prerequisite for the success of NSQF.
- The competency based curriculum package would consist of syllabus, student manual, trainers guide, training manual, teacher qualifications and multimedia packages and e-material.

RMSA, Dept. of Primary & Secondary Education, Govt. of Karnataka is the designated agency to implement this project in Karnataka state. They have already started this initiative in 100 Secondary Schools from 2014-15 onwards. The project will intro-



duce skill training to more than 5,000 students (100 Schools X 50 students) in the first year itself. Out of 100 schools, Automotive Sector will be introduced in 57 schools which consist of 25 students from each school for Automotive Sector. BREADS-DB Tech is the implementing agency to impart skill training in automotive sector in 57 Schools. It is a recognition for BREADS-DB Tech for our long years of involvement in training the youth in vocational skills. The process has already started and job applications for the instructors and other personnel are called for the project. The project will encourage the students to learn vocational skills along with their formal education thus contributing to fill the skills gap of India.
