# National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF)

*Nurturing skills and entrepreneurship among school students*



NSQF organizes qualifications for students according to a series of levels of knowledge, skills and aptitude. National Skills Qualifications Framework is a nationally integrated education and competency based skill framework which provides multiple pathways, horizontal as well as vertical, both within vocational education and vocational training thus linking one level of learning to another higher level. This will enable the student to acquire technical skills and competency, transit to the job market and, at an opportune time, return for acquiring additional skills to further upgrade the skills and competencies. Govt. of Karnataka launched this framework during the year 2014 . BREADS DB Tech is a partner of NSQF and implementing skill training for 1425 students in Automobile sector across Karnataka state.

## NSQF training in Automobile by BREADS DB Tech

BREADS DB Tech has been successfully imparting the skill training in Automobile skill with a reach out of 57 government schools. The project is being well executed and there have been many positive results and feedback about the same. Almost all the students are very happy to be part of this training initiative and reaping fruits from this project. the project is implemented in every school by one qualified and experienced Trainer in Automobile and the children undergone 200 hours of practical and theoretical training. This includes the industrial exposure, guest lectures and life coping skills. The trainers keep up to their roles and responsibilities and building a rapport with all the children, teachers, industries, garages, service stations, manufacturing units and so on to give the



best to the students.



From this BREADS DB Tech spread its wings to touch the lives of poor youngsters, numbering to 1425 students (57schools X 25students). Thus 57 Automobile trainers were already added to the skilled workforce to Karnataka state in the last academic year. Activities were carried out with the regular monitoring system by visiting to schools and interacting with children and teachers.

The selected schools organized various activities in order to increase the interest of the children and facilitate better learning and results. The multipronged pedagogy introduced by BREADS DB Tech boosted the spirit of the students. It was pleasant to see local people involving themselves by giving scrap materials required for the practical classes. Two

of the schools i.e. Karwar and Koppal got two wheelers donated by well-wishers for the purpose of practical classes.
