Empowering Marginalized Youth to be Productive Citizens



DB BEST Academy is the new venture of BREADS to skill and employ marginalized youth by facilitating them to realize their potential. This new center is located at 14th Cross, Gundappa Mutt Road, across Don Bosco Church, Lingarajapuram, Bangalore. The foundation stone for the four-storied building was laid on 9 July, 2016 by Rev. Fr. Joyce Thonikuzhiyil, Provincial, Salesian Province of Bangalore. It took more than a year of hard work for the realization of the center.

The center was blessed and inaugurated on 10 October, 2016. The blessing ceremony started with a small prayer and the unveiling of the plaque by Rev. Fr.

Joyce Thonikuzhiyil. Mr. Rakesh Gajaria, Vice President, Operational Tax Utility, Deutsche Bank, Bangalore, along with Mr. Solomon Devaraj, Chief Corporate Responsibility Officer, AXA Business Services, Bangalore, inaugurated the building by cutting the ribbon. The academy building consists of classrooms, computer labs, a food and beverage lab, a suite room for housekeeping practicals, staff rooms, dormitories for both boys and girls, etc. Youth between the ages of 16 to 30 will be considered for training. The DB BEST Academy begins the training of its first batch towards the end of November 2016.
